### **UPDATE/REFRESHER SEMINARS:**

Update/refresher seminars are for those who have attended and completed a full day seminar within the last three years, or have maintained a current certificate by attending an update/refresher seminar every three years after the completion of the full day seminar.

In addition to evening sessions that run from 7-9pm, participants in 2018 now have the option of attending an afternoon session of any scheduled full day seminar. This session has been strategically designed to meet all the standards of an update/refresher seminar (1.15 to 3.15pm)

Please note that pre requisite reading material will now be distributed for both full day and update seminars, and must be read prior to attending the seminar, as it will be subject to an assessment process within the seminar.

**Certificates:** Will be issued within 7 days of the seminar.
