Bequest Wording

Below are some examples of wording that can be used in a will for the purposes of a bequest to the Baptist Churches of South Australia Inc.

These paragraphs can also be used if you wish to add a bequest an to one of our churches. Just replace the name, address and position (see *italicised* items below) with that of the church you wish to support.

It is recommended that you seek professional advice when preparing a will.

A specific sum

I give and bequeath (free of all duties) the sum of \$..... to the Baptist Churches of South Australia Inc of 35 King William Road Unley SA 5061, to be used in such a manner as its Board determines. I declare that the receipt of the Chief Executive Minister or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

A percentage

I give and bequeath (free of all duties) % to the *Baptist Churches of South Australia Inc* of 35 King William Road Unley SA 5061, to be used in such a manner as its Board determines. I declare that the receipt of the *Chief Executive Minister* or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

The residue

I give and bequeath (free of all duties) the residue of my estate to the *Baptist Churches of South Australia Inc* of *35 King William Road Unley SA 5061*, to be used in such a manner as its Board determines. I declare that the receipt of the *Chief Executive Minister* or other authorised officer shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.

Specific purpose bequeath

If the bequeath is to be used for a specific purpose, then the line "for the specific purpose of(describe what you want the gift to be used for), but if such purpose cannot in the opinion of the Board be achieved, then" can be inserted between the address and the words "to be used in such a manner as its Board determines."
