

In 2020, our churches have decreased their focus on evangelism, with 47% of churches listing evangelism as a weakness or not a priority, compared to 43% last year




52% of our churches reported that they are 'quite' or 'very' connected to the most vulnerable in their community, a 4% increase from last year


Our overall health is improving

In 2020, 29 of our churches scored above 60 for both, up from 23 churches in 2018




Leader Demographics




WOMEN IN LEADERSHIP

55% of those in leadership roles are women, increasing from 51% in 2019

AGE & LEADERSHIP


in 2020, the number of leaders under 40 decreased by 7% from 2019, while leaders Aged between 40-70 increased by 9.9%



Pastoral Growth

Pastors were asked to what extent they felt as though they had grown throughout 2020.

87% of our pastors felt as though this year had stretched them either 'somewhat' or 'a lot'. In 2019, only 75% of pastors noted a similar selfgrowth.
